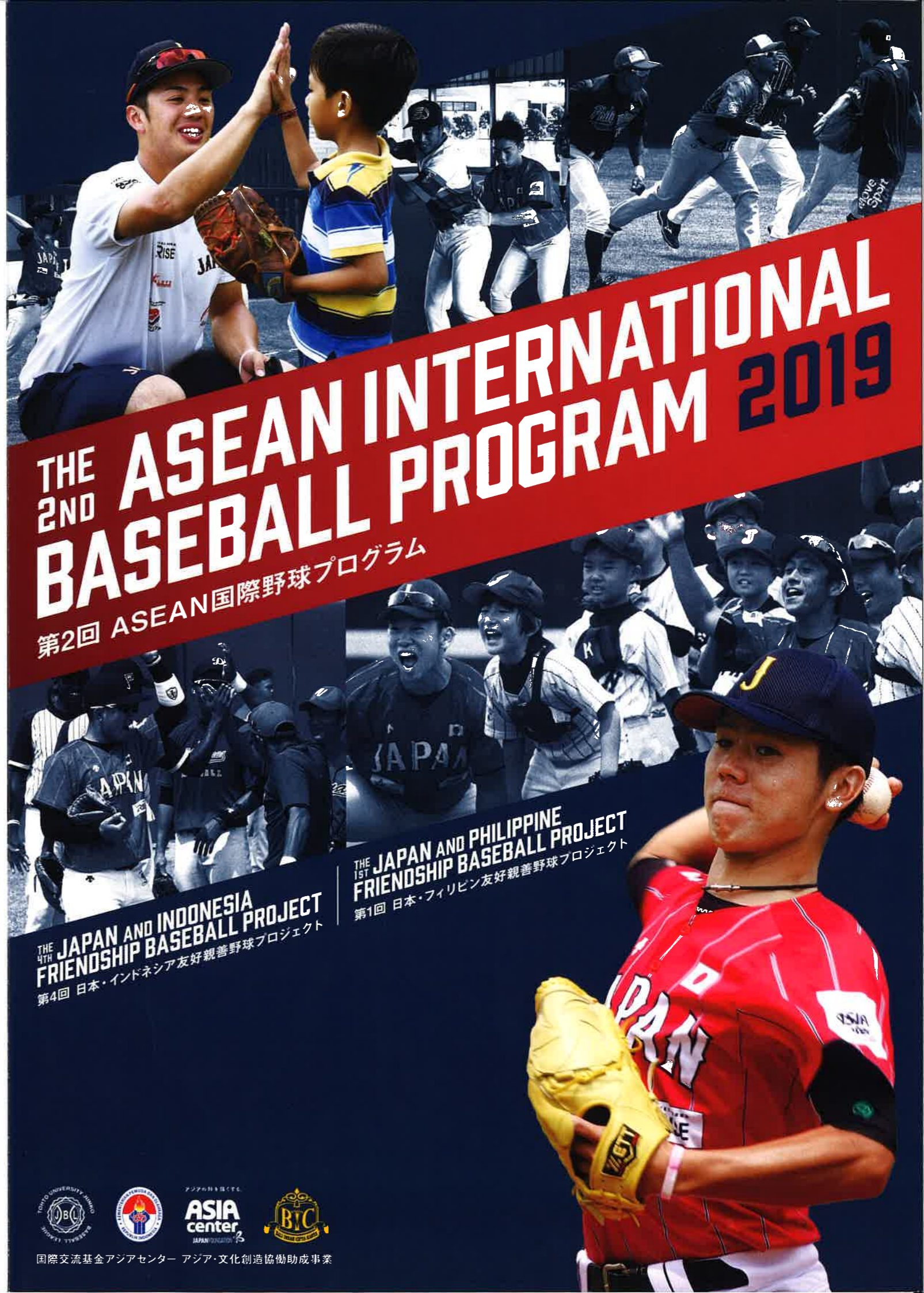
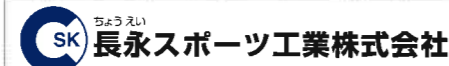

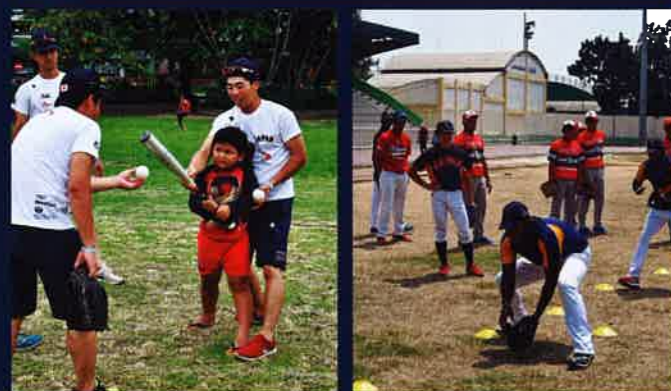

直径が7センチメートルほどの白いボールを、投げて、打って、捕るという、野球というスポーツが持つ力を信じて、インドネシア国と始めた国際文化交流も、早いもので今年で4回目を迎えることとなりました。その間には、インドネシア国家スポーツ省と東都大学準硬式野球連盟との野球普及に関する提携を結び、指導者養成プログラムは、今やアジア5か国の参加を得られるようになりました。インドネシア国公認アドバイザーである野中寿人氏、東都大学準硬式野球連盟理事長五味敏雄氏をはじめとして、関係各国の関係者、協賛していただきました企業の関係者の皆様、そしてマネジャー、トレーナー、選手の諸君にこの場をお借りして心より厚く御礼申し上げます。

もう一方で、小中学校への野球教室の開催や、公園などでの野球キャラバンも継続して行います。野球とはどういうものか、ボールを投げたり、打ったりすることがどれくらい楽しいものなのか、我々が経験したわくわくした気持ちを、現地の子供たちに伝えることで、野球の普及に結び付けていきます。

わずか2週間ではありますが、その2週間で体験したすべてのことは、必ずや今後の人生の大いなる糧になることを願ってやみません。

さあ、野球を始めようではありませんか!

Follow What We Believe in “Power of Baseball” for International Cultural Exchange in Asia

Following our belief that the power of baseball, a sport that is played basically by throwing, hitting and catching a white ball in a diameter of about seven cm, will benefit our bilateral relations, we ventured to launch an international cultural exchange project with Indonesia, which, as time flies, already celebrates the fourth year in 2019. During these years, the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Indonesia and the Tohto University Junko Baseball League of Japan formed a partnership to popularize baseball in both Indonesia and Asia, making the baseball leadership training program grow to the extent that it is now attended by the teams sent by five Asian countries.

I would like to take this writing opportunity to express our sincere appreciations to Mr. Kazuto Nonaka, baseball advisor to the Indonesian Ministry of Youth and Sports, Mr. Toshio Gomi, chief director of the Tohto University Junko Baseball League and those concerned in each of the countries involved, and those concerned in the corporate sponsors, as well as the managers, trainers and players of the baseball teams.

We realize that the power baseball has to offer has been steadily spreading its positive influence across the region. We sincerely hope that it will involve not only ASEAN countries but also the rest of Asian countries and eventually the entire Asian region, ultimately being evolved into international exchange and cultural exchange through baseball.

One of the purposes of this program is to gain feedbacks from the participants in the baseball leadership training program held in this August. This provides an opportunity for us to check if the participants may keep what they have understood in the program in the right way, as well as to check if their competitiveness has been improved even under different circumstances, both culturally and environmentally, through communication we keep with the participants after the program. This program is also designed to review if not only the games and drills for skill improvement but also the entire initiative may be going well, and we believe that the review will show we will have good results as we expect.

On the other hand, as part of the program, we do and will continue to visit local elementary and junior high schools to provide baseball lessons and to hold baseball roadshows at public parks, etc. to teach children how to play baseball. Through these efforts, we communicate what baseball is all about, how fun it is to throw and hit a ball and how excited we have felt in playing the sport as children, to local children, leading to the popularization of baseball in the countries. The program runs only two weeks but we sincerely hope that for participating children, all their two-week experiences will provide food for life in the future.

Now, join us, let's play baseball!

PURPOSE :

1. Gain feedbacks from coaches and players who participated in the leadership training program held in August 2019;
2. Build a new bilateral human exchange base between a baseball advanced country of Japan and each of two baseball developing countries of Indonesia and the Philippines by holding baseball games and training sessions for skill enhancement for young adults and by visiting local elementary and junior high schools to hold baseball lessons and by organizing baseball roadshows and other events to promote the sport among children who have never played it, in the three respective countries;
3. Learn the culture and historical background of each of Indonesia and the Philippines through communication by using SNSs and other media and build a scheme, based on cultural/historical differences between each country and Japan, that allows each country to improve baseball skills under a different environment to actually promote local payers' skill improvements;
4. Provide opportunities to actually play games to learn how to make motions during the game and to develop a physical sense to play that players cannot acquire only by being taught the theory, thereby further improving the proficiency of their skills; and
5. Japan will win the gold medal in the baseball event at the 2019 SEA Games to further promote the popularity of baseball in the region.
